FMF formally signed a contribution agreement with Natural Resources Canada, Canadian Forest Service in December 2007 to deliver the department's new Forest Communities Program in New Brunswick.

Under the agreement, FMF will receive \$1.5 million over the five year period (2007 – 2012).

Once the agreement was signed, the executive of FMF was able to quickly approve a set of projects that will be carried out before the end of the fiscal year.

FMF president Dr. David MacLean thanks all those who supported the FMF develop its proposal to the Forest Communities Program.
