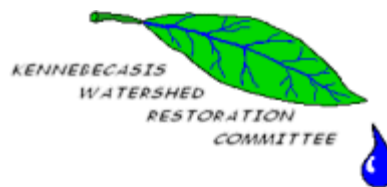
Workshop topics are:
